Rule Governing Barrier Seal Application: Issued October 6, 2003; effective January 1, 2004 – Item 2250C

The shipper is responsible to protect the safety and integrity of its lading, including but not limited to, the application of barrier seals to railroad cars to prevent unauthorized access to its lading. A minimally-accepted barrier seal will be composed of braided steel strands (high tensile strength steel cable) totaling one-eighth (1/8) inch in diameter.
